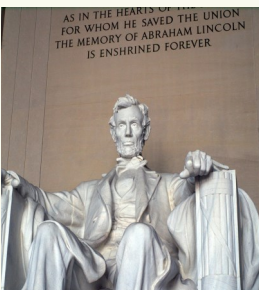
Day 3

Day 6



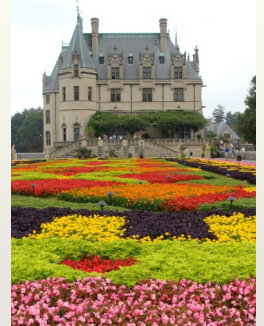
