

Hot Springs, AR & Pioneer Woman

(6 Days, 5 Nights)

Day 1:

We'll start our tour with a scenic drive to **Little Rock, AR**. Upon arrival we'll visit the **William J Clinton Presidential Library** where you'll see what the former President's daily calendar looked like and learn a little about the history of the White House.



Day 2:

This morning we'll travel to **Hot Springs, AR** where we'll tour the **Fordyce Bathhouse** which is also the current visitor center for **Hot Springs National Park**. You'll have time to shop, visit some local museums. This afternoon we'll visit **Hot Springs Mountain Tower** where the tower elevator will transport you 216 feet to the observation decks. You'll enjoy breathtaking panoramic views of the Ouachita Mountains and the Diamond Lakes area.

Day 3:

This morning we'll travel to **Crater of Diamonds State Park** where we'll have a picnic lunch (weather permitting) and you'll have the chance to dig for diamonds. This afternoon you have free time to shop, visit or experience the relaxation of the natural hot springs thermal bath at the Buckstaff Bathhouse (*on your own*). This evening, we'll freshen up for a dinner cruise on the **Belle of Hot Springs Riverboat** (*included*). We stay a second night in **Hot Springs**.




